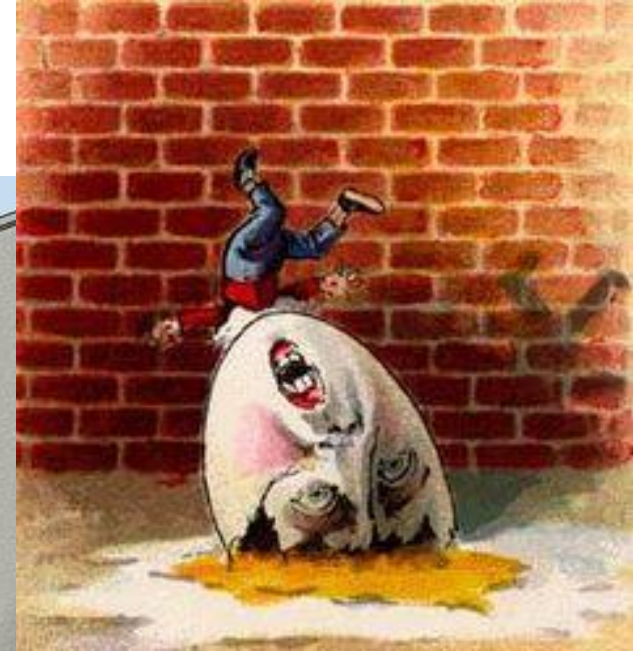
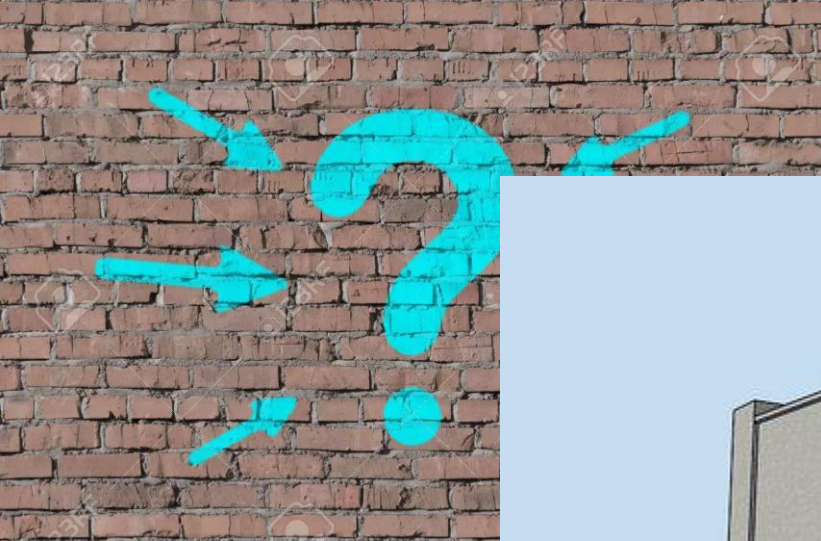

- Propose a strategy for expanding this assessment model to other interventions

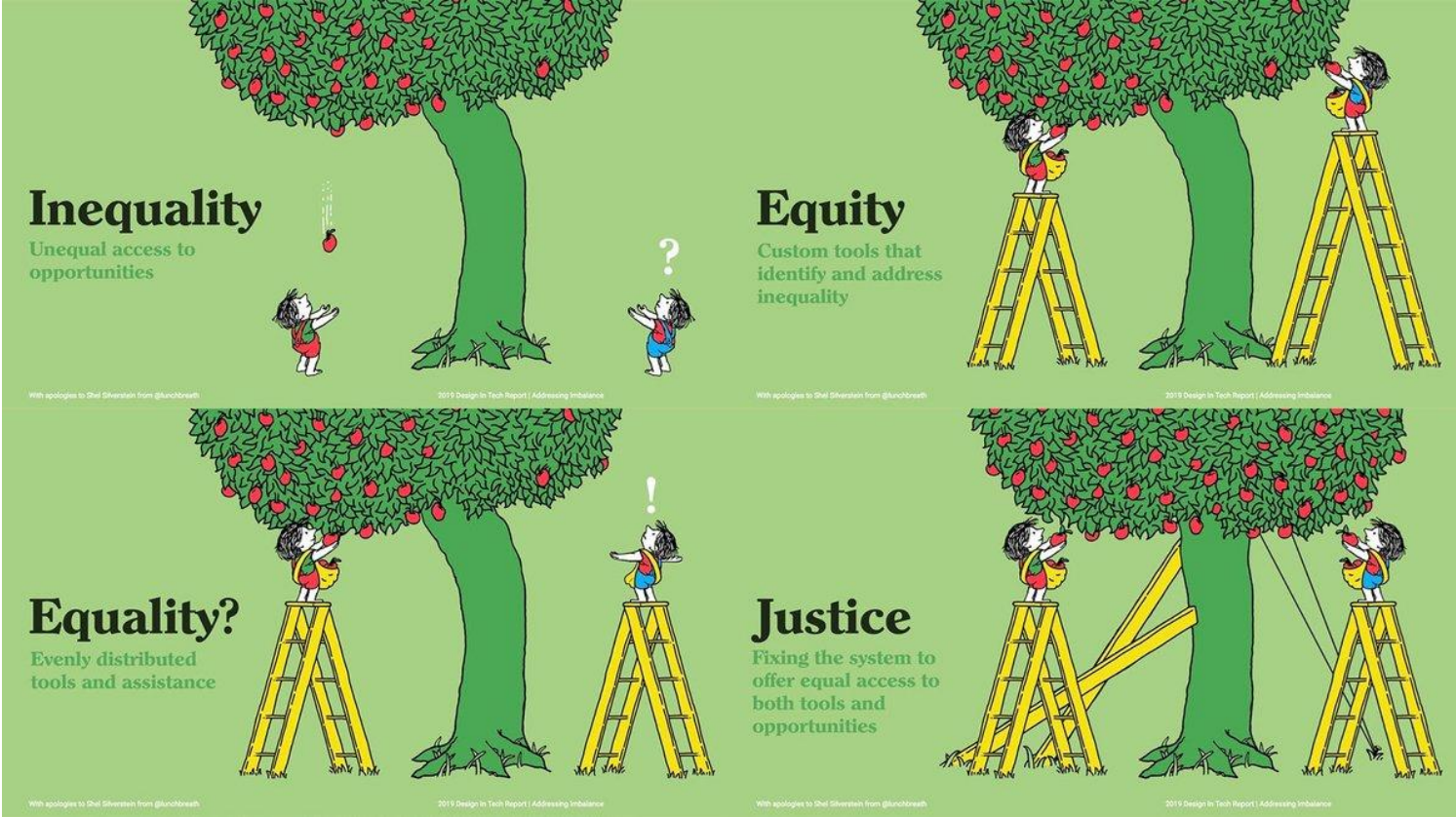
# Finding Families

- Result: Families identified, and the Difficult to Treat Asthma Clinic is working on obtaining written consent through mail/clinic visits

- Result: EPIC referrals are working- 1 success story
- Result: Improved understanding of barriers when working with CCHMC
- Goal: Propose a strategy for expanding this assessment model to other interventions
- Result: Impact Survey

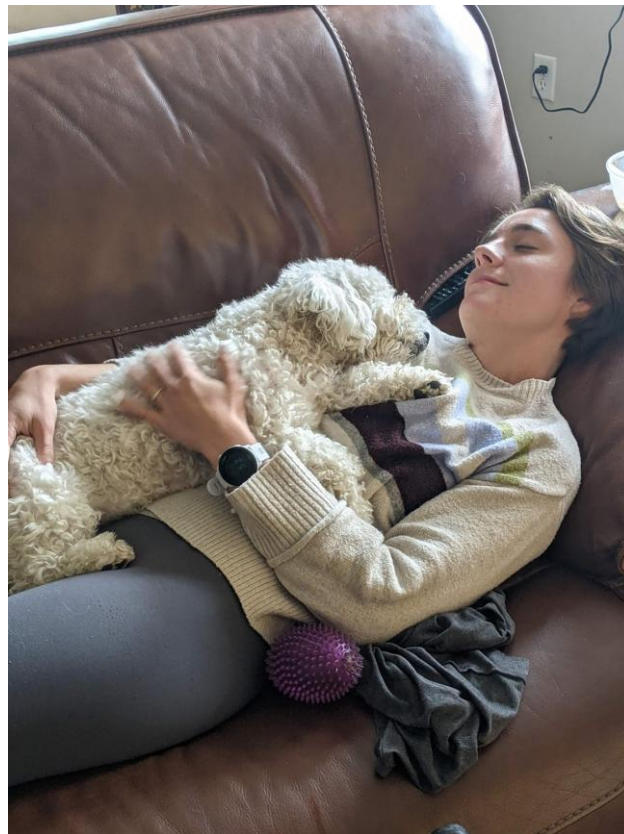
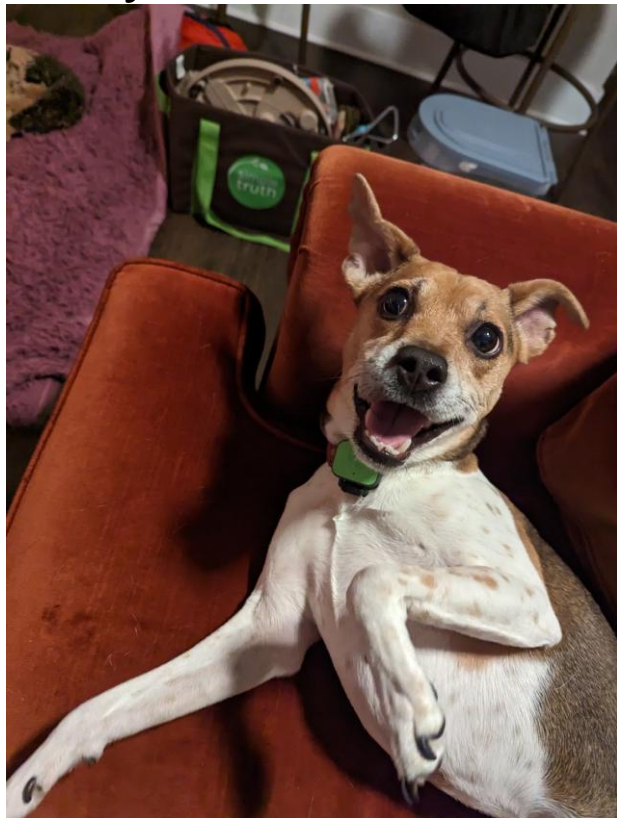
